

Rzadki przypadek nerwiaka osłonkowego języka

A rare case of schwannoma of the tongue

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Summary

Author described a rare case of lingual Schwannoma in 20 years old female. After complete surgical excision she has not shown recurrence during 2 years of follow-up. Schwannomas are peripheral nerve tumors of nerve sheath origin. Extracra-nial schwannoma in the head and neck region comprise 25-45% of all shwannomas, but only 1% are located intraoral and usually present as slow growing mass of long duration, producing few symptoms. The treatment is surgical excision
